## Introduction

## **Courtesy and Equipment**

Have your classroom tools, i.e., computer, notebook or binder, writing utensils, calculator, etc. with you when you arrive. Leave your desk and area around you as neat as or better than when you arrive. Do not write on any part of the furniture.

## **Electronic Devices**

You will use your chrome book to perform certain course activities. Please leave your chromebook, personal computer, electronic reader, iPad, etc. powered off and under your desk until a request for their use is made. Phones should remain in your locker during class time. DO NOT bring your phone to class.

## Homework

Due at the beginning of class, your homework represents you. Be thorough and neat. Late work will be accepted, however, will result in a loss of 20% of the total points each 24 hours after the due date. Homework grades will be lowered an additional 20% each day they are late. Be thorough and neat. Some work will be hand-written then turned in directly, however, some work will be submitted via Google Forms and Google Classroom. Edited Google Docs and Sheets must print well. Be sure to complete all required areas on Google Forms. Late work will be accepted, however, will result in a loss of 20% of the total points each 24 hours after the due date.
